School Status Report-

Ms. Sainato:

- NYC implementation visit—very happy with how it went. Michael Feldman conducted the visit from 8:00-2:30 in classrooms 20-30 minutes, 2 classes per grade and was looking at implementation of HMM
- He said how well we were doing compared to other schools
- Compliment to teachers, admin team, and coach
- Next visit is in May
- PID letters were sent home
- Receiving additional AIS services, afterschool looking for progress by end of year
- ENL compliance visit with Mr. Castro
- Kudos to Ms. Bugge, Ms. Grech, and ENL team; got meeting standards across the rubric
- Ms. Bugge: Policy visit to go over compliance and rubric to make sure that ENL protocol is being followed
- Ms. Sainato: PPO visit for Monday 2/12/24 was scheduled, however, Dr. Pretto came only a short time as he received notice the chancellor was calling a remote snow day and was called for a meeting regarding the remote snow day
- Will get back to us with new date and let everyone know
- Today's pivot to remote learning—system had crashed in the morning but teachers worked through it
- Compliments to teachers for working so hard with children, they were engaged and learning today
- School survey info sent home; encouraged to complete it to help us get better as it is a time to share thoughts to improve

CEP Update-

Ms. Bonomolo:

- Attendance update for Remote Day—only about 100 absent
- CEP Goal: ALL DISTRICTS AND SCHOOLS ARE MORE INCLUSIVE AND RESPONSIVE FOR PARENTS AND FAMILIES, INCLUDING HAVING MORE FAMILIES CHOOSE NYC PUBLIC SCHOOLS—looking to see this increase about 94%; important to see this come up on survey
- We are helping getting families involved more—can translate things more easily now so all families can see and understand and we can communicate with families
- PTA meeting attendance is up in January
- CEP goal: ALL STUDENTS GRADUATE COLLEGE AND CAREER READY AND HAVE A STRONG PLAN AND PATHWAY TO ECONOMIC SECURITY

- Working toward this through Civics for All; increasing from 14%-100% of classroom participation
- Students are working on participatory budgeting and Student Organization to help support the civics goal
- Student Organization was comprised of 5<sup>th</sup> graders with 4 positions—president, vice president, treasurer and secretary
- The structure was changed and is now more representative with representatives per grade with students from 3, 4,5 representing K-5; they meet with students from each grade level to work together
- Ms. Racioppo: Last year just introduced civics with 3 lead classes and those classes participated in Soapbox
- This year all K-5 classes and all launched the year with soapbox advocating change for their community; worked on research, speech writing process, voting for representative for Soapbox presentation
- 3/11-3/15 Civics for all week
- Participatory budget—Ms. Sarullo and Ms. Figueroa worked with S.O. leads on these ideas—water bottle filter for school, recess equipment, school store
- 2/12 school wide vote; students looked at speeches and listened to proposal for each idea and then voted
- During Civics for All week results will be viewed; District Civics for All week K-5 representatives to present Soapbox speeches
