- Chronic absenteeism—17% unlikely to decrease: travel abroad and can't make it up
- iLog—reason for absences
- Chronic does not have to be consecutive
- PreK & K biggest attendance gap
- Kindergarten campaign to target
- Staying healthy in winter; what's permissible to still come to school or keep home; PTA have nurse present to help
- If it is iLogged and recorded it still counts as absence but school is being accountable; more information the better

Nour- Some parents may think that it is their responsibility not school's as long as they keep up with the work and have a doctor's note. I only know this because of SLT
