- 2 red pens

- 1 pocket dictionary
- 1 pack of dry erase EXPO markers
- 1 scissor
- 1 box of 24 count Crayola crayons
- 1 box of Crayola washable markers
- 1 box of Crayola colored pencils
- 1 bottle of glue
- 1 large glue stick
- 1 Correction tape
