P.S. 204 SLT Minutes

- Laura Bonomolo discussed previous minutes and all approved
- Tomasuolo
 - Blended Learners 33%
 - Remote Students 67% (692 Fully Remote Students)
 - Blended Opt In (Convert from Remote to Blended) will be 11/2 – 11/15. NYC DOE has disclosed that this will be the only opportunity to consider going back to Blended. Ngai suggested if numbers stay consistent, will school consider converting to a 2 Cohort option. Tomasuolo; If #'s stay same maybe move from 3 to 2 cohort.
- Grading Policy:
 - No longer will percentages be provided. District 20 will convert back to 1 – 4 Rating. November report card will reflect new grading policy
 - Breakdown is as follows:

Grade	Percentage
1 = N (Approaching Grade Level)	0 – 64%
2 = N (Approaching Grade level)	65 – 79%
3 (Grade level)	80 – 91%
4 (Above grade level)	92 – 100%

- Report cards can be accessible through NYC Schools Account, also via TeachHub
- CEP Update:
 - Developing CEP – DOE Guideline (November 16, Approval date into iplan portal)
 - Not required to complete entire CEP plan “updating year” due to COVID
 - P.S. 204 Good Standing
 - 3 smart goals: Action Goals, Progress Monitoring
 - Need to revise the goals based on iReady for Reading & Math the resubmit for approval
 - Ipads – 300 were ordered
 - Ngai - Emphasis in including budget set aside for technology upgrades/investment to better support faculty and students
 - Students to bring electronics to school to emphasize electronic base learning
 - Prior to COVID, school ordered 350 ipads and cabinet in Library.
 - Now we are providing ipads to students with wifi to connect to parents hotspots.
 - Large amount of funding towards technology
- Workload & Social Emotional
 - PTA Parent – not enough SEL, to much work
 - Should adjustments be made to workload? Should we add more social and emotional support?
 - SEL – Sanford Harmony, Respect for All
 - Ngai – feels keep to standards
 - Carrique – Keep doing what they are doing
 - Angie, Victoria agreed with Ngai – PS 204 to maintain existing standards and consider critique the individual student/family workload.

- Continue to incorporate SEL into conversations and daily lessons.
- COVID Testing
 - Students who showed fear were not tested
 - What the protocol for how long the closure is for?
 - Covid Symptom: Nurse – Staff – Isolation – student
 - Health Policy is according to DOE Policy: 2+ cases linked in two different classes – close building
 - 10/28 – Was the first testing. Went over smoothly. Minimal – not uncomfortable at all. Congratulated students.
 - Yellow Zone will be weekly tests.
 - Tomasuolo – continued discussing protocols.
